The practice of tikanga, kawa and culture of the Society is as follows:

We respect the dignity of all people. We know that in serving others, we are fulfilling God's will of justice and love among all people and that we may live together as members of one family. Therefore, we commit ourselves to following Jesus' example and, in the power of the Spirit, to exist as a serving, caring community and our Constitution shall be interpreted having regard to that practice of tikanga, kawa and culture.

- a) **\$100 annually for Representative Members** (this is any parish, congregation, church social service or governing church body that supports the purpose of the Society. A Representative Member shall have all the rights and privileges of a Member and shall be subject to all the same duties as a Member and will be represented by such delegate as it notified in writing to the Society from time to time).
- b) **\$10 annually for a Member** (this means a person, body corporate, or Representative Member who has consented to become a Member of the Society and has been properly admitted to the Society who has not ceased to be a Member of the Society).
